What: Seneca Lake Youth Camp is a student camp near Seneca Lake, Ohio. Seneca Lake

Youth Camp is an amazing week and includes morning and evening worship sessions, free time to swim, participate in various sports tournaments, and hang with friends. Students will also participate in a series of fun, team games known as Color Wars.

Why: At Seneca Lake, students will be challenged to strengthen their relationship with Jesus.

This will be done through challenging messages from the week's speaker and worship will be led by Joe & Chloe Bennet.
