Introduction

Digging IN

This week's message focused on becoming a “people of the journey.” Pastor Jeff emphasized the story of the 12 spies in **Numbers 13:25-14:10**. In this story, we saw how 10 of the spies, after going into the land, had forgotten who the real owner of the land was. It wasn't the opposition's, it was God's. They responded with FEAR, instead of FAITH.

1. What principles do you see in **Numbers 13:25-14:10** that could help you remember who the real owner is of everything we have?
2. Out of these 3 questions Pastor Jeff emphasized, which one is easiest for you to negatively fall in to? Why?
 - a. Who will you see?
 - b. What will you believe?
 - c. How will you speak?
3. Read **1 Chronicles 29:10-27**. Circle/Highlight/Underline anything you hear in this passage that answers any of those questions above you answered negatively.
 - a. What statements in this passage caught your attention? Why?
 - b. How does this passage help us respond with FAITH instead of FEAR on our journey?

4. Pastor Jeff continued to reiterate that Jesus is the “lead pastor” of our Church. It was said, “that our beliefs are determined by what we focus on.” Read **Colossians 1:15-20**.

a. How does that passage help us as a people on our journey?

b. What are the top two or three ideas from that passage to help you remember who Jesus is, and what he has done for you?
