Quick Review

Look back from your sermon notes – Was there anything that particularly challenged you from this sermon? Anything you didn't understand, agree with or connect with?

Introduction

Describe a time in your life where it was incredibly hard for you to keep a secret.

Under what circumstances do you want to be “in the know” about things going on, and when would you rather be “in the dark” about what is going on?

Digging In**Read Revelation 10**

Pastor Jeff went over 6 different Truths about God's Word as it relates to Revelation 10.

Question 1: *God's Word should be Supreme.* **Read Revelation 10:2-3.** God shows his complete authority and supremacy in these verses. How has God's truth and word been supreme in your life this week? How have you fallen short of putting God's authority as the supreme authority in your life this week?

Read Hebrew 4:12

Question 2: *God's Word should be Sufficient.* **Read Revelation 10:4.** How do you trust that God has given you everything you need from His Word to live the life He wants you to? What often times distracts you from that?

Read Deuteronomy 29:29 & 2 Peter 1:3

Question 3: *God's Word should be Submitted and Satisfying.* **Read Revelation 10:8-9.** The writer, John takes the little scroll and eats it. How have you “consumed” God's Word this week? Was it sweet to your lips or bitter to your stomach? In what ways has God's word been sweet to you?

Read James 1:22, Matthew 4:4, Psalm 119:102-10

Question 4: *God's Word should be Sobering and Shared.* **Read Revelation 10:10-11.** The reason that the Word of God will be bitter in the belly is concerning the judgement being pronounced and the sharpness of the two-edged sword. How have you experienced God's Word to be bitter before? After the Apostle John digests the scroll, he is told he will "share this again with many peoples, nations, languages and kings" (v.11) John must consume the words of God in order to share the words of God with others. How does this look in your life? Is this happening in your life? Why or why not?

Read Romans 10:17, Isaiah 55:11

Taking it Home

In Revelation 10:8-11, the Lord asked John to do something peculiar: eat the scroll. John without question did what the Lord asked him to do. Is there an area in your life where you have done or not done what the Lord has called you to do? What is God calling you to do based on this week's sermon?

Confession – What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?
