**Introduction**

Can you describe a time in your life where you received both “good” news and “bad” news almost at the same exact time? What was the news pertaining to?

**Digging In****Read Revelation 14:6:12**

Pastor Jeff taught through three different angels in **Revelation 14** and their different messages that they proclaimed: **Angel 1**: Proclaimed the Eternal Gospel (**v.6**), **Angel 2**: Predicts the fall of Babylon (**v. 8**), **Angel 3**: Promises God's Wrath (**v. 10**).

**Question 1:** Pastor Jeff describes the purpose of the first Angel was to proclaim the eternal good news. There was a clear message that God wanted people on the earth to know – the Eternal Good News. Pastor Jeff asked, “Have you received the Good News?” What do you think the is difference between receiving the Good News and knowing the Good News?

**Read Matthew 7:16-20.** What does receiving/believing the Good News do?

**Question 2:** Pastor Jeff asked the question, “Are you living out the Good News?” The first evidence of that came in **verse 7**, when the angel said to “Fear God.” What does it mean to fear God? How does this look in our lives?

**Read Proverbs 1:7, 9:10.** How would you describe how the Bible says fear of God should look?

Pastor Jeff said that the “fear of God is an awareness of His presence.”

**Question 3:** The second evidence of “living out the Good News” was to “Give God Glory.” Pastor Jeff said this, “Being a Christ follower means you have new goals, it means we become selfless instead of selfish.” What are ways that you have seen your life glorify God that wouldn't have been there before? What are specific ways you give God credit for the things in your life?

**Read 1 Corinthians 10:31** – What does this verse show about glorifying God?

**Question 4:** The third evidence of “living our the Good News” was to “Worship God.” The person who has received the Good news will worship God with their lives. How do you see this happen in your life? What ways do you find yourself worshipping God? How does your heart at times want to worship other things? How do you keep your focus on worshipping God and not other things?
