

LifeGroup Study Sheet**May 30th 2021– Revelation of Jesus Christ – Part 27**

This guide is designed to help in preparing you for your group discussion.

Quick Review

Look back from your sermon notes – Was there anything that particularly challenged you from this sermon? Anything you didn't understand, agree with or connect with?

Introduction

Describe the best wedding you've ever been to or been part of. What made it so great? Why do you remember it so vividly? Was it the ceremony, the food, the dancing, the people, etc.?

Digging In

Read Revelation 19:1-10 Pastor Jeff talked about the Marriage Supper of the Lamb and the importance of this celebration! He spoke about (1) the People that will be there, (2) The Parts of the wedding, and (3) the Purpose of the wedding.

Question 1: Read Revelation 19:7-8. The author of Revelation is describing what he heard when this marriage super of the Lamb begins. And one of the things that is described is the readiness of the bride for that day. She (the Bride) has been given her linens to wear, bright and pure. How are you preparing yourself for this wedding feast? In what ways does Scripture encourage you to prepare yourself for that day?

Read Titus 3:8, Ephesians 2:8-10 (emphasize verse 10), Matthew 25:21

Question 2: Read Revelation 19:9 The author of Revelation then said he heard the angel acknowledge the invitation to this magnificent wedding feast. There is a blessing and honor for those who have been invited. The invitation to this wedding feast was planned before the foundation of the world (**Ephesians 1:4**). All of those in attendance will have received and accepted an invitation to come. How are you sending invitations out for people to come to this wedding feast?

Read Isaiah 25:6-9

Who are you going to talk to this week about inviting them to this wedding feast?

Question 3: Read Revelation 19:10. John, the author of Revelation was in such awe of what he was hearing about this marriage feast that he fell down in worship. There should be a great anticipation and excitement about attending this wedding feast. John was in so much excitement and awe in only HEARING about it, let alone getting to experience it! How do you prepare your heart in worship for this feast? How are you reminding yourself of this day and what it will be like?

Question 4: Jesus is described as “King,” “Messiah” and “Lamb” in the Book of Revelation. Why do you think this marriage feast is described as the Marriage Supper of the Lamb? What is the significance of this title? How does this title remind you of what Christ has done on your behalf?

Read John 1:36 and Rev 5:6, 13:8.

Praise / Prayer Requests

Pray for your group with these things in mind:

Adoration – How can I praise God for what this teaches me?

Confession – What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me?

Thanksgiving – How can I thank God for what Jesus has done?

Supplication – What do I need to ask of God in order to grow in light of this?
