

### Quick Review

Look back from your sermon notes – Was there anything that particularly challenged you from this sermon? Anything you didn't understand, agree with or connect with?

### Introduction

The Millennium Kingdom, or the Thousand Year Reign will happen after Satan is bound in the pit. Scripture says that this happens so that Satan can no longer “deceive the nations” for that time (**20:3**). How do you see Satan deceiving in our world today?

### Digging In

**Read Revelation 20:1-10**

**Question 1: Read Revelation 20:1.** An angel comes down from heaven with the key to the “bottomless pit.” Remind yourself of how John describes Jesus in **Revelation 1:18**. How do these passages relate to each other? How do these verses encourage you about who God is?

**Question 2:** After Satan is bound, Scripture teaches that Jesus will reign on Earth for 1000 years (**20:4**) During this 1000 year reign, there will be political peace and worship. **Read Isaiah 2:1-5**. The last verse asks the people of God, House of Jacob, to walk in the light of the Lord. They are asked to do this because of the great anticipation of what will come. How are you walking in the light today, knowing what the future holds for those who are in Christ? Does your life have an expectation like that?

**Question 3: Read Zechariah 14:8-9.** Jerusalem is conquered, divided and plundered. But God then goes out to fight against the nations and becomes ultimate king (**v. 9**) Literal living waters will come forth from Jerusalem (**v. 8**) This is describing the fulfilled reign of Jesus during the 1000 year millennium kingdom.

These verses show that Jesus will fulfill all unfulfilled prophecy throughout the Bible. How does that encourage you in your current life situation?

**Question 4: Read Revelation 20:4.** Jesus will reign on the throne of David (**Zech 8:3**). Jesus will reign over the entire earth. Is Jesus currently reigning in your life right now? Are you giving him the ultimate authority in your life currently? **2 Corinthians 13:5** says to test yourself to see if Christ is in you!

- **Romans 8:16** – the Spirit of God gives Christian's assurance we are His child.
- **Peter 2:2** – Christians want to grow in their salvation through God's Word.
- **Galatians 5** – walking in the Spirit, growing in the fruit of the Spirit
