2. All story videos will be clearly labeled, so make sure you are watching the correct day's and age groups story video.
3. There will be 4 worship songs available for you to use on rotation every day. We recommend doing 2 worship songs every day. It's actually better that you repeat songs the kids like so they can remember and sing along the next day.

1. Make sure to check out Spotify and look up Press Play VBS and you'll find a playlist of songs to use during your welcome time or downtime throughout your day. If you have a portable wireless speaker bring it out and get that music going!

Tech Support - FAQ's

Q: How Do I Show The Videos In My Front Yard/Back Yard/Garage?

A: There are many ways you can do this depending on what you have accessible at your home.

1. You can "share" the videos from any device you have to a tv that is mobile enough to move to the environment where you'll be having story time. If you are in need of a tv on wheels for this purpose... GPC will loan you one, just let us know if you need it.

2. You hook a laptop up to a projector and display it in your garage (lighting is key, if you do it outside it may be too bright to see anything). Have fun with it, make a clear space in your garage and set out blankets for kids to sit on.

3. If you have downloaded the videos you can upload them to whatever device you have whether its a laptop or a tv. We have extra flash drives here at the church if anyone needs an extra one.
