


LifeGroup Study Sheet

Quick Review

Look back from your sermon notes – Was there anything that particularly challenged you from this sermon? Anything you didn't understand, agree with or connect with?

Digging In

Question 1: Read Acts 2:1-4. Pastor Jeff said the people of God are powered by the Spirit of God. The church was formed in the passage by the dwelling of the Holy Spirit inside those who followed Jesus. This is now the defining characteristic of a Christ-follower.

Read John 14:15-17

How does this promise make you understand your relationship with God? Is your relationship with God being led by this promise? Why or why not?

<u>Question 2: Read Acts 2:22-24.</u> The people of God are preaching the Gospel of Jesus! Pastor Jeff talked about the Gospel being part of our everyday language as Christ-followers. How do you intentionally bring up spiritual conversations with people around you? What are ways you can speak the name of Jesus into relationships you already have?

<u>Question 3: Read Acts 2:42-47.</u> The people of God are participating in the mission. Pastor Jeff shared how all people now who were following Christ were on the same mission. Day by day they were doing things together and worshipping together. They were sold out for this mission. How does this passage change your perspective on "church?" How do you think this should look in central Ohio in 2022?

<u>Question 4: Now What?</u> Pastor Jeff asked the question – Now What? Where does our church go from here? God is bringing new people, families, and kids. And we want to move along with what God is already doing.

Pray individually and as a group how God might use you and your family in the coming weeks as to how you can be involved in what God is doing at GPC.

Pray for your group with these things in mind:

<u>Adoration</u> – How can I praise God for what this teaches me? <u>Confession</u> – What sin can I confess because of what this teaches me? <u>Thanksgiving</u> – How can I thank God for what Jesus has done? <u>Supplication</u> – What do I need to ask of God in order to grow in light of this?
